Funk Gem & Mineral Museum Tour - Shirley, IL

The Funk Gem and Mineral Museum is central Illinois' largest collection of minerals, fossils and gemstone materials open for touring. Earning the nick-name "Big Chunk Funk", at age of 53 LaFayette Funk II fell in love with rocks and minerals while on a field trip with his son. Over the next 30 years he assembled one of the largest private gem and mineral collections in the world. Travels for the Funk Bros. Seed Company allowed him to acquire specimens from locations even the Smithsonian's collection does not include. In addition to minerals, there are separate collections of fossils, central Illinois Indian artifacts, Chinese soapstone carvings, seashells and corals. There is also a room of fabulous fluorescent minerals.

Funk Prairie Home

Marquis de LaFayette Funk built the Prairie Home in 1863 and 1864 with timber felled in Funks Grove. In 1864 LaFayette married Elizabeth Paullin and continued a family legacy that began before the birth of our Nation. Visitors to the Prairie Home will see much of the original furniture, including rosewood and walnut pieces shipped from Philadelphia. All thirteen rooms of the Prairie Home are fully decorated and open for viewing.
